As an artist, Nancy Good has presented many workshops and learning opportunities for her community. From “exquisite corpse” style sessions that engage the spirit of collaboration among the attendees, to mixed-media workshops that allow students of all ages play and discover new mediums and/or techniques, to collage classes that invite students to create new images from pieces and parts of other images, Nancy is comfortable leading workshops that flow, organically based upon the skill levels, age, and attention of the people in attendance.

Additionally, her talks on everything from her Burning Man experience and how it informs her art, to her personal healing from early childhood abuse, domestic violence and even her life on the road, living out of a van, allows her to create inspired, honest and often deep connections with the people she meets during these talks. The therapeutic aspects of art, and how arts and culture connect people of very divergent backgrounds, are common threads through her stories.
